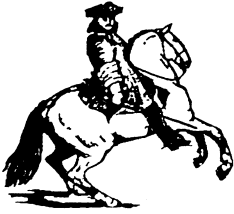

Location of Show

Hartpury College - Equine Unit, Gloucester. GL19 3BE, is on the A417, 4 miles north of Gloucester. You are advised to approach from the M5 or M50 motorways, to avoid heavy traffic around the town.

From the M5:

Leave at junction 11 and follow the A40 towards Gloucester. At the first roundabout, turn towards Ross-on-Wye. At the third roundabout, take the A417 towards Ledbury. After leaving Maisemore, the College is signposted at the second turning on the left.

From the M50:

Leave at Junction 2 and follow the A417 south towards Gloucester and Hartpury. Continue for approx. 10 miles. The College is signposted to the right.

Friday 27th August – Heather Moffett Clinic – evening International Arena

Following the success of our Founder Sylvia Loch's special clinic at our 25th anniversary show last year, we are delighted to be able to bring you this opportunity to take part in another clinic at our annual breed show, with trainer, author, saddler and founder of Enlightened Equitation, Heather Moffett.

Heather will first demonstrate the Classical Seat and aids, and show the correct synchronisation with the movement of the horse, then the incorrect, to illustrate how much bad riding affects the performance of the horse. She will need a horse to ride so if you have one you are willing for her to ride please contact Cassy our Show Secretary.

The clinic will be divided into three sections and will be along the lines of a traditional clinic with each section running for approximately 45 minutes with two participants per section. Heather will work the individual horses and riders to develop skills, increase confidence and harmony between horse and rider.

The cost to take part in this clinic is £40 per person.

Please do come along as a spectator if you are not taking part. Spectating is free and everyone is very welcome to come along and watch.

Participation will be on a first come basis and you will need to provide a brief overview of the level that you are riding at and also anything that you would particularly like to work on.

1st & 2nd from each age group from these classes go through to the Youngstock Championship, which will be judged immediately after the class 2.

Class 3: Purebred Mares with foal at foot

Class 4: Purebred Mares 4 years and over - winner receives the **Russell Cup**
1st & 2nd from each age group from these classes go through to the Purebred Female Championship, which will be judged immediately after class 9.

1st & 2nd place from all age groups from classes 1 & 2 Young stock champion will receive **The Johnson Sash**

In-hand Part bred Lusitano

Class 5: Part bred Colts 1 – 3 years
1st & 2nd from each age group from these classes go through to the Part Bred Championship, which will be judged immediately after the class 8.

Class 6: Part bred Fillies 1 – 3 years
1st & 2nd from each age group from these classes go through to the Part Bred Championship, which will be judged immediately after the class 8.

Class 7: Part bred Mares and Geldings 4 years and over – class will be split if necessary
1st & 2nd from each age group from these classes go through to the Part Bred Championship, which will be judged immediately after class 8.

Rosettes to be awarded to horses placed in the top three in each age group. Classes will be split if there are sufficient entries. Please note that it is the competitor's responsibility to make sure that they are ready with their horses when the Championships are due to be judged. Classes will be timed to minimise male and female classes running simultaneously. Please see timing on the day.

Saturday 28th August International Arena – divided into 2 rings

Ridden Lusitanos

Class 8: Part bred Lusitano any age - class will be split if necessary
1st & 2nd from each age group from these classes go through to the Part Bred Championship, which will be judged immediately after this class.

PART BRED CHAMPIONSHIP

Please note that it is the competitor's responsibility to make sure that they are ready with their horses when the Championships are due to be judged.

Class 9: Purebred Mares 4 yrs + over – winner receives the **Carreg Dressage Cup**
1st & 2nd from this class go through to the Purebred Mare Championship this class.

Class 10: Purebred Gelding any age – winner receives the **Jagosto Trophy**

– winner receives the **TAP-Air Portugal Challenge Trophy**

CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS - Overall Purebred Champion Male and 2nd and Overall Champion Purebred Female and 2nd - Winner receives The Monty Memorial Cup

Saturday 28th August International Arena – following on from Championships

Class 12: Parade Class

Come and “strut your stuff” in wonderful Portuguese/Spanish outfits. In the event of large numbers, divisions to the class will be made. Horses that are registered with The Association for the Cruzado Portugues in Portugal may also take part in the Parade class, and in any dressage classes. All competitors entering the Parade class must be in traditional Portuguese or Spanish dress.

The idea of the Parade class is to emulate the atmosphere of the Golega fair where horses parade for the audience and to give you the opportunity to show off your horse in the most entertaining way. There is no individual test.

Any rider deemed to be riding in a dangerous way or being inconsiderate to other horses and riders will be eliminated at the steward’s discretion.

The Belleza Trophy to the best Spanish Parade horse

The Portuguese Tourist Office Cup for the most correct traditional Portuguese dress.

The Outen Cup for the best Part bred Lusitano Horse

DRESSAGE TO MUSIC - 20m x 60m

Music to be supplied on CD only please and must be handed to the Show Secretary by 12 noon clearly marked with the rider’s name and competitor number, and the name and track number to be played.

Class 13: Freestyle to Music - Novice, Elementary or Medium level, to be clearly stated on entry form. A British Dressage test. Riders in English dress.

The winner will receive **The Neopolitana Fantasia Shield**.

Saturday 28th August International Arena

Class 14 : Open Freestyle to Music

This is an open class to be ridden in costume which will form part of the judging marks. The costume may be traditional i.e. Portuguese or Spanish or may be of your own design. Please read the rules set out below. Numbers will be limited in this class.

Freestyle to Music Competition

Freestyle to Music is a 'pick-n-mix' the British Dressage way, allowing riders at all levels to compete in a single class. Each rider will be judged according to his or her stated level (please see entry form).

This year there is no nominated dressage level. The competition will be based on fun and entertainment but will be judged using British Dressage guidelines. You simply design your ground pattern to include walk, trot, canter, lateral works etc. with any additional movements at which your horse excels. This is all set to music in a 20m x 60m arena.

Judging

The dressage judge will assess the overall dressage performance of each competitor. Additional marks can be achieved for more advanced movements if they are correctly performed. If your horse is not yet established in a more advanced movement you may achieve higher marks by keeping your test within your horse's capabilities, thus creating a balanced and harmonious test. In other words, the judge will mark the higher-level horses more critically to equalise the competition for all levels. Scoring will be based around two judges. One judge will assess the dressage element and one the entertainment and costume value. Scoring will be made on score cards from 1 to 10 from each judge, so a maximum of 20 points.

Dress Code

This class must be ridden in traditional dress or in costume. The entertainment judge will award a maximum of 5 points for traditional dress and additional points for the extravagance and suitability of the costume. Extra points can be gained for costumes judged to be effectively designed, produced and themed with the music, therefore novice horses have an equal chance of winning if the costumes and music are creative and innovative. Any competitors wishing to enter as pairs must state this on the entry form and the entry fee is per rider. Props such as a Garrocha or Vara poles, pillars etc, must be declared before 2pm on Saturday before the competition to ensure there are no health and safety issues.

Music must be supplied on CD, which will be loaded into and played from a computer to ensure we do not have any issues with broken or scratched CD's.

Music must be handed in by 12pm on Saturday clearly marked with the rider's name and competitor number and track name and number to be played.

Finally, ALL competitors **MUST** complete the section which asks for brief details of you and your horse which is for the commentator. LBSGB is hoping to attract members of the public as well as our specially invited guests and sponsors and your details will assist the commentator in providing announcements and information which will ensure that we present an entertaining and professional competition.

Saturday 28th August - International Arena – divided into 2 rings

In-hand Spanish PRE, Part bred + Hispano Arab - Male

Class 40: PRE Males 1 – 3 years
1st & 2nd from each age class will go through to the Male Championship which will be judged immediately after class 42. 1st & 2nd placed gelding go through to the Champion Gelding Award which will be judged immediately after the Male Championship.

Class 41: Male Part bred + Hispano Arabs - All ages
1st & 2nd place will go through to the Male Championship that will be judged immediately after class 42. The two highest scoring geldings are eligible for the Champion Gelding Award that will be judged immediately after the Male Champion.

In-hand Spanish PRE, Part bred + Hispano Arab - Female

Class 43: PRE Females 1 – 3 years
1st & 2nd from each age class will go through to the Female Championship which will be judged immediately after class 45.

SPANISH PURE BRED YOUNGSTOCK CHAMPIONSHIP

Class 44: Part Bred Spanish & Hispano Arabs Females 1 – 3 years
1st & 2nd from each age class will go through to the Female Championship which will be judged immediately after class 45.

Class 45: Spanish females 4 years and Over. Open to pure
1st & 2nd from this class will go through to the Female Championship which will be judged immediately after class 45.

Class 45a: Spanish females 4 years and Over. Part bred and Hispano Arabs

SPANISH FEMALE IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP

Class 42a: Spanish Part Bred Males - 4 years and over
Open to part bred and Hispano Arabs

Please note that it is the competitor's responsibility to make sure that they are ready with their horses when the Championships are due to be judged. Classes will be timed to minimise male and female classes running simultaneously. Please see timing on the day.

Class 26: Advanced Riding Horse Open to Pure & Part-bred Lusitano only
May include all movements.

Class 27: Open Riding Horse Open to Pure & Part bred Lusitano, Spanish & Hispano Arabs
May include movements at elementary level, but not above.

The Golega Stirrups Trophy is presented to the best Lusitano horse from either class 26 or 27.

Class 28: Ridden Veteran Horses aged 15yrs & over, any sex.
Pure/Part-bred Lusitano, Pure/Part-bred Spanish horses.

Winner receives **The Dolling Trophy**.

Breeders Award

This is an award to encourage and recognise breeders in the UK. The following points are awarded to the breeders of the horses who are placed 1st – 5th in each purebred class. The award is given to the breeder whose horse collects the highest number of points.

2nd 4pts

3rd 3pts

4th 2pts

5th 1pt

Gold Medals 5 bonus pts

Silver Medals 3 bonus pts

Champion Male/Female 5 bonus points

Reserve Champion 3 bonus points

Champion of Champion 5 bonus points

Warm up area for all classes in the small outdoor arena.

The Lusitano Breed Society of Great Britain was established in 1984 to promote the Lusitano horse in the UK. In 1990 it became affiliated to the APSL, the governing body for the breed in Portugal, thus enabling Purebred Lusitano horses born in the UK to be registered in the official studbook in their home country.

The Society issues Passports, organises an Annual Breed Show and supports Lusitano classes at shows all over the country. A magazine entitled 'Luso News' is published giving information regarding training, breeding, displays and events in the UK and abroad.

SHOW RULES & CONDITIONS

1. The Show is organised by members of the Lusitano Breed Society of Great Britain (est. 1984) Limited, who are not professional show organisers. In entering the Show, you acknowledge that you accept all risks associated with entering a show being run by non-professionals.
2. The Lusitano Breed Society of Great Britain (est. 1984) Limited, its officers and show committee do not accept any liability for the loss of, or damage to property, or for any consequential or indirect loss.
3. All horses must be registered with their relevant breed society; either the L.B.S.G.B or B.A.P.S.H. Evidence of registration will need to be provided to enter all classes.
4. The organisers will take necessary precautions to ensure Health & Safety of persons on the showground. It is a condition of entry to the showground that competitors and spectators will act on any instruction given to them by the show organisers in so far that it can affect the Health & Safety of all. All competitors and spectators must take due regard to Section 7 of the Health & Safety Act and have due regard for the safety of others.
5. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entries.
6. Entries will not be accepted unless competitors sign the recommendations on the entry form regarding hard hats.
7. The organisers reserve the right to change classes, judges and times as circumstances dictate.
8. Classes may be split, merged or cancelled depending on numbers of entries received.
9. The judge's decision is final.
10. Objections must be made in writing and handed to the Show Secretary within 30 minutes of the incident, with a deposit of £20, which is only refundable if the objection is upheld.
11. Stallions and colts must be exhibited in a properly fitted bridle or cavesson.
12. Horses that misbehave or are under inadequate control, or riders or handlers who act in a manner unacceptable to the judges or show organisers will be asked to leave the show ground immediately with no refund of entry fees.
13. Horses, riders and handlers should be neatly attired in either correct English dress or the appropriate traditional dress for the class entered. Full details of correct Spanish showing tack and dress may be found on the BAPSH web site.
14. Entrants exceeding the time allowance in the freestyle to music by more than 30 seconds will be eliminated.
15. Dressage classes will be run under the rules of the relevant societies.
16. Ridden showing classes to be ridden in a snaffle, double bridle or Pelham. Riders to be in English dress unless otherwise stated.
17. Excessive use of the whip or spurs will NOT be tolerated.
18. Entry constitutes an agreement to abide and be bound by the SHOW RULES
