Now UK based, Charlotte travels to Sweden and Portugal to teach and is the author of a 4-part illustrated guide to working you horse in hand, published in the LBSGB magazine Luso News and shortly available on our website, www.lusobreedsociety.co.uk.

Working Equitation team GB and development squad trainer, who competed for Portugal at both GP dressage and WE, helping the team win five European championships. After five years training with Maestro Luis Valença Paulo studied with eminent dressage trainers, including five years with Finish Olympic rider Kyra Kyrklund.

6.15pm Richard Chamberlin garrocha clinic

Richard trains horses and riders of all levels, from walk to piaffe, is an Iberian judge and author of Helping You To Understand The Basics. After watching riders work with the garrocha in Spain in the 1980s, Richard caught the bug with a vengeance. He went home, made a garrocha, and spent hours studying a video of Sebastian Fernandez doing an art display, "Fantasia Con La Garrocha." He went on to give his own displays with his PRE Lucero. More recently he trained former sprint racehorse Maraagel to work with the garrocha, and the pair gave a stunning display at last year's Lusitano Breed Show.

Purebred Lusitano Championships

All Champions qualify for the Lusitano Supreme Show Championship on Sunday afternoon. The Champion and Reserve Champion Colts, Fillies, Mares and Stallions qualify for the Breeding Champion of Champions judging on Saturday evening, which is restricted to entires.

Champion Mare, for the Grayson Stud Cup, open to 1st and 2nd placed horses in classes 8, 9 and 14.

Champion Gelding, for the Jagosto Trophy, open to 1st and 2nd placed horses in classes 10 and 15.

Champion Stallion, for the Opalino Cup, open to the 1st and 2nd placed horses in classes 16 and 17.

Best British Bred Female for the Tamareira Cup, to be chosen from the highest placed British bred in the pure and part bred Lusitano filly and mare classes.

Best British Bred Male, for the Monty Memorial Trophy, to be chosen from the highest placed British bred in the pure and part bred Lusitano colt, gelding and stallion classes.

Clear Round Jumping

The clear round jumping course, not to exceed 65 cm, will remain open for at least 60 minutes. There will be a 10 minute warning before the ring closes. Enter on the day, pay a £5 entry fee to the ring steward for each round. No restriction on the number of entries per horse. A rosette for each clear round jumped. Use the course as a warm-up for the Novice Jumping class, or a training opportunity. As competitors already entered in any Breed Show classes can enter other classes on the day, riders can take their horses round the clear round before deciding whether to enter the Novice Jumping, which will be a hole higher.

Class 34 Novice Jumping

Not to exceed 70 cm in the first round, no doubles.

Class 20 Freestyle Costume Dressage To Music

Open to Lusitanos, Cruzados and Invited Classical Breeds. To be run under BD rules. Riders may compete as individuals, pairs or in larger groups, but each rider must pay an entry fee whether competing individually or in a group. Open to all levels, from Prelim to GP. The Espirito Santos Cup for the highest percentage score. Trophy for the best horse and rider costume. How the levels are divided for placings is at the discretion of the judge. There will be a cap on the number of entries accepted for this class.

Lusitano Purebred Breeding Champion of Champions for the PMP Hotglass Plate

Open to the Purebred Lusitano Champion and Reserve Champion Colts, Fillies, Mares and Stallions. The winner goes forward to the Lusitano Supreme Championship on Sunday afternoon. Championship and Reserve Championship sashes and rosettes will be awarded.

The Breeders Award

To be awarded to the British breeder gaining the most points in the Lusitano showing classes for horses they have bred: 1 point for a 6th place, 2 points for a 5th, 3 points for a 4th, 4 points for a 3rd, 5 points for a 2nd, 6 points for a 1st, 7 points for a Reserve Championship, 8 points for a Championship, 9 points for the Reserve Champion of Champions, 10 points for the Champion of Champions.

Purebred Lusitanos and PREs can achieve qualifying scores to compete for Team GB at the Masters Du Cheval Iberique European Championship in Paris this autumn. May be ridden in English or Traditional Portuguese or Spanish dress.
